

Roles and Responsibilities



Vice-President Men's

The Vice-President is the human resources department for the men's team and deals primarily with personnel-related activities. He is responsible for all stages of a member's relationship, from recruiting to alumni. He will represent the men's team as registrar with Sportngin, or affiliate. The Vice-President Men's should be skilled in dealing with people and a good administrator that can keep track of members and their contact information. He shall be a current member in good standing. It is preferred that he have an understanding of MS Access databases, MS Excel, and email programs as these are the primary tools for administration.

- 1. Recruit new members college, experienced and inexperienced adults, international, and military players
- 2. Integrate new members into the club make sure they are introduced to other members, have a contact on the team and know critical information
- 3. Track members' contact, background, and emergency information keep it current on shared web sites and have it on hand for matches.
- 4. Ensure club and players are eligible for matches by complying with league and club requirements.
- 5. Monitor club morale and suggest team building social activities
- 6. Communicate with Alumni/Old Boys
- 7. Develop relationships with other clubs
- 8. Share the duties of the President in his/hers absence
- 9. Succeed the President in the case of the President's resignation, expulsion or death until the next AGM
- 10.Act as the Men's representative at all Men's Rugby fixtures and Men's hosting events
- 11. Attend monthly Executive meetings
- 12. Act as a executive representative member of all assigned subcommittees
- 13. Be responsible for undertaking any reasonable duties the Executive may request of him
